### 上海市外商投资协会换届相关会议召开，选举产生新一届领导班子

3月23日下午，协会第九届会员代表大会暨第九届理事会第一次会议召开。市商务委朱民主主任出席会议并讲话、诸旖副主任出席会议。

会员代表大会以举手表决的方式，通过了第八届理事会工作报告、《上海市外商投资协会章程（修订案）》等8项内容。会员代表大会以无记名投票的方式，表决通过了《上海市外商投资协会会费标准及管理制度（修订案）》。选举产生了第九届理事会的208名理事和第二届监事会的5位监事。

第九届理事会第一次会议以无记名投票的方式，选举黄峰先生担任第九届理事会会长、贺利氏（中国）投资有限公司大中华区总裁艾周平博士等64人担任副会长。理事会以举手表决的方式，通过了《关于新设绿色低碳发展分会的议案》等6项议案。协会第一届至第八届理事会副会长、正大集团资深副董事长李绍祝先生受邀担任协会名誉会长，范红女士受聘担任协会秘书长。

## 协会活动

### “中国资本市场里程碑式改革——A股全面注册制时代开启”讲座

3月2日，协会携手君合律师事务所上海分所举办了“中国资本市场里程碑式改革——A股全面注册制时代开启”讲座，邀请到了君合资本市场部的陶旭东律师，为参会企业介绍并解答有关全面注册制下企业A股上市过程中遇到的各类问题，并针对外资企业在中国

境内上市中的特性问题进行了分析。本次讲座采用了线下讲解与线上直播相结合的方式，共 40 余人次参加。

### 人力资源领导人早餐研讨会

3 月 3 日，协会人力资源分会组织会员单位人力资源领导人开展了小范围研讨会，共同探讨企业如何增强团队能力，提高员工体验和应对领导力的新挑战。16 位来自不同企业的人力资源领导人参加，协会会长黄峰出席并参加了讨论。

研讨会由协会人力资源分会副会长、史宾沙人力资源顾问（上海）有限公司全球合伙人丁海英女士主持。三小时的研讨，人力资源领导人以所在企业发展现状为契入点，从人力资源视角提出了当前重点关注的课题，其中，大家对灵活办公是否能够提升员工工作体验和如何制定执行标准进行了较为深入的探讨；同时对年龄歧视，就业机会普遍表达了关注，尤其对四零、五零、六零员工技能转型和再就业这一话题，部分人力资源领导人分享了解决思路和企业的实践经验。（图 11）

### 外企志愿服务工作委员会：3 月云南公益支教行

3 月 6 日至 10 日，协会外企志愿服务工作委员会在云南省怒江州开展了第二次公益支教行活动。协会副会长兼秘书长刘生和来自安利、云南太古可口可乐、伊顿、联拓、福特汽车、索尼和恒天然 7 家协会会员企业与上海宋庆龄基金会、九号站心理工作室共 9 家单位的 17 位志愿者参加。

在老窝镇中学，志愿者们分别进行了捐赠仪式和支教活动。伊顿（中国）投资有限公司向初一学生捐赠了 174 双运动鞋。云南太古可口可乐饮料有限公司捐赠了一批饮用水。太古公司在 2022 年 9 月就已认领了“耕读计划”和“教师电脑计划”，并捐赠了 1500 册图书和 15 台教师电脑。伴随着课外书籍的捐赠，同步设立了“阅读之星”的奖项评选活动。学校老师通过学生们平日和寒假中的读书情况评选出 253 位“阅读之星”。此次太古的志愿者们在进行支教后，也为得奖的同学们颁发了奖品。联拓、福特汽车和上海宋庆龄基金会的志愿者们给初一孩子带来了英语和医学的支教内容。

### 数据出境安全评估政策宣讲会（商务站）

3 月 9 日，数据出境安全评估政策系列宣讲会（商务站）召开。本次宣讲会由上海市网信办、上海市商务委主办，上海市外商投资协会承办，本市 63 家企业代表参加。市网信办通报了目前数据出境安全评估申报受理情况，介绍了相关法律法规及申报材料注意事项。市信息安全测评认证中心专家重点围绕数据出境风险自评估实施及报告撰写进行了辅导。交流答疑时，针对企业代表提出的数据量统计、出境链路梳理、评估整改要求、法律环境描述等方面问题进行了回应及解答。

特斯拉（上海）有限公司

特斯拉于 2003 年成立于美国硅谷，作为综合性可持续能源公司，业务覆盖电动汽车、太阳能板，以及储能设备等，提供了从能源生成、存储到运输的整体服务。特斯拉拥有两个能源生产基地与四个整车生产基地。特斯拉旗下涵盖了 Model S、Model X、Model 3、Model Y 等高性能全智能电动汽车，有效降低了全球交通对不可再生能源的依赖，推进



交通低碳化的进程。同时，特斯拉车辆在质量、安全和性能方面均达到汽车行业领先标准，并提供融合尖端技术的自动辅助驾驶（Autopilot）、智能售后服务、以及完备的充电解决方案，为人们带来优质的驾乘感受和拥有体验。

2013 年，特斯拉正式进入中国，在京设立总部，在沪设立生产工厂、研发创新中心和数据中心。未来，特斯拉将持续全面加大在华投资和业务布局，将更多先进技术、产业理念、流程和标准带入中国，加强全产业链人才培养，助力新能源汽车产业链创新和发展。

### 明治（中国）投资有限公司

明治中国（投资）有限公司成立于 2019 年 1 月 8 日，2019 年 2 月获得中国区地区总部认定，是日本明治集团在华全资子公司。目前公司员工约 300 人。主要业务为面向中国市场销售低温牛乳·酸奶、巧克力糖果、雪糕冰淇淋、运动营养食品、业务用商品等。

明治集团是日本食品行业最大的企业集团，拥有 100 年以上的历史，制造并销售包含婴幼儿奶粉、牛乳、乳制品、糖果、运动营养品及高龄者流动食品在内的种类丰富的产品，不仅为各种年龄段消费者的健康与幸福做出贡献，并在日本国内多类主要产品市场份额中占据首位。

### **Seminar on "Milestone Reform of China's Capital Market: on the A-Share Market's Registration-Based IPO System"**

On March 2, SHFIA joined hands with JunHe Law Offices (Shanghai) to hold a seminar on "Milestone Reform of China's Capital Market: on the A-Share Market's Registration-Based IPO System". The seminar invited Tao Xudong, a lawyer from JunHe's Capital Market Department to introduce and interpret various problems encountered in the A-share registration-based IPO system. He also offered questions specific to foreign companies' domestic listing need in China. Adopting a hybrid form of offline presentation and online livestreaming, the seminar was attended by more than 40 people.

### **Breakfast Seminar for HR Leaders from SHFIA's member enterprises**

On March 3, SHFIA's human resources branch organized a small-scale seminar for HR leaders from member enterprises to discuss how companies can enhance team capabilities, improve employee experience, and deal with new leadership challenges. 16 HR leaders from different member enterprises participated in the seminar, where Huang Feng, Chairman of SHFIA, also joined the discussion.

### **SHFIA's foreign enterprise volunteer service committee visited Yunnan to support rural education and development**

From March 6 to 10, SHFIA's foreign enterprise volunteer service committee carried out the second public-service education activity in Nujiang Prefecture, Yunnan Province. Liu Sheng, then Vice Chairman and Secretary-General of SHFIA, led the trip with 17 representatives from 7 member enterprises including Amway, Yunnan Swire Coca-Cola, Eaton, LianBio, Ford, Sony and Fonterra, and 9 organizations such as the Shanghai Soong Ching Ling Foundation.

At Laowo Town Middle School, the volunteers carried out a donation ceremony and teaching support activities respectively. Eaton China donated 174 pairs of sports shoes to junior high school students, while Yunnan Swire Coca-Cola donated free drinking water.

In September 2022, Swire Pacific volunteered to shoulder the school's student reading program and teacher computer program, donating 1,500 books for students and 15 computers for teachers. Along with the donation of extracurricular books, the company also launched the "Star Reader" award. The school teachers selected 253 "Star Readers" based on the students' reading performance on weekdays and in vacations.
